



Vicksburg Miss
Jan. 25th 1865

Dear Cousin Mary:

Having a little spare time I don't know as I can improve it better than by writing to you so here goes: Well to begin with we have moved camp since I wrote to you and are now encamped at Vicksburg Mississippi about four hundred miles south of Memphis; We have got the best camp we have had since we have been in the service, good houses for our selves and stables for our horses; And we expect to stay here this summer, and if you would be so kind considering and obliging as to send me some morning glory seeds, I will send you the first flower that I see down here to pay for them and be very thankfull in the bargain; As to sending you my girls phiz I can't do it no way in the world as I have but one of them and she is made just now

so you see it woud do to ask her for another
 just at present; At least I think she is mad
 for I have not heard from her this year: Did
 Aunt Mar get the letter I wrote her
 this time: Tell Aunt Mary that I
 will write to her as soon as I have time
 after I pay my debts: I owe Smith King
 a letter and one to Emma & Rooie and
 then I am square with the world: But I
 cant think of any thing to write so I guess I
 will stop trying: Give my love to all my
 friends Mary Seaman in particular: Write
 soon, sooner, soonest, to your true friend, and
 Well Wisher, and loving cousin
